Argyll

- September and January intakes
- Fully online, option to study with/without scheduled sessions or tutorials – recordings of sessions are available to access online
- You will undertake mandatory in-person invigilated assessments - 11 over the year, at your nearest UHI Argyll campus or learning centre, plus 2 practical days in Thurso
- Full-time: 1 year @ 15 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 8 hours per week
- Part-time modular: 17 weeks @ 2 hours per week (per module)

Inverness

- September only
- In-person, on campus
- Part-time (day-release): 2 years @ 8 hours per week

Moray

- September only
- In-person, on campus
- International students requiring a Student Route visa can apply to study at this campus
- Full-time: 1 year @ 14 or 16 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 6 hours per week
- Part-time modular: 17 weeks @ 2 hours per week (per module) (dependent on timetable and availability)

North, West and Hebrides

Online

- September and January (Jan PT only)
- Fully online, option to study with/without scheduled sessions or tutorials
- You will take part in a mandatory online induction in, or just before, the month that your course starts
- You will undertake mandatory in-person invigilated assessments - 11 over the year, at a UHI Partner campus, plus 2 practical days in Thurso
- Full-time: 1 year @ 15 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 8 hours per week
- Part-time modular: 17 weeks @ 2 hours per week (per module)

Stornoway

- September and January
- Online with scheduled sessions and tutorials, plus 33% spent in-person, on campus in Stornoway, including in-person invigilated assessments and practical days
- You will take part in a mandatory online induction in, or just before, the month that your course starts
- Full-time: 1 year @ 15 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 8 hours per week

Thurso

- September and January
- In-person, on campus (3 out of 15 sessions will be held online in the evening)
- You will take part in a mandatory in-person induction in, or just before, the month that your course starts
- International students requiring a Student Route visa can apply to study at this campus
- Full-time: 1 year @ 15 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 8 hours per week

Orkney

- September and January
- Fully online, option to study with/without scheduled sessions or tutorials
- You will undertake mandatory in-person invigilated assessments - 11 over the year, at UHI Orkney campus, plus 2 practical days in Thurso
- Full-time: 1 year @ 15 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 8 hours per week
- Part-time modular: 17 weeks @ 2 hours per week (per module)

Perth

- September only
- In-person, on campus
- International students requiring a Student Route visa can apply to study at this campus
- Full-time: 1 year @ 15 hours per week
- Part-time: 2 years @ 6 hours per week
- Part-time modular: 17 weeks @ 2 hours per week (per module)
