What is an RPL task and what do I need to do now?

As part of your conditional offer onto the BA Childhood Practice degree, you are required to show that you have the knowledge, understanding and skills related to early years and childcare, which are equivalent to the first year of a degree. The RPL Portfolio tasks will enable you to do this as they are designed to help you evaluate, record and present evidence of your knowledge related to what you do in your practice.

Please choose one of the tasks in the RPL level 7 tasks document that is most applicable to your practice experience.

The length of each essay will vary from student to student, but it is expected that each one will be between 1,000 - 1,200 words long. It is also expected that at level 7 you show your knowledge and understanding through reading and therefore referencing your work, please use the UHI short referencing guide to help you do this. In addition, there is an example of an RPL task to support your understanding of the required task.

When you have finished the task, please email this to the BA Childhood Practice Personal Academic Tutor to be marked. Contact details are included in your offer notification. Subsequently when your essay has passed your offer will be changed to unconditional.
