The university will run a competition for those students who activate and set up their personal profile on the UHI Careers and Employability Platform, Handshake



The UHI Careers and Employability Team will gather all names of students who activate their Handshake accounts and complete their profiles. The six winners will be picked at random on 1st February 2024 and announced the following week.

Our legal reasons for using the data are:

To achieve the following purposes:

Purpose 1: Administration and running of student prize draw, Purpose 2: Prize Draw, Purpose 3: Publication of some entries and announcement of

the six winners.

Our legal reason to use the data is: Legitimate interests.

UHI considers that the processing is in keeping with its legitimate interests, this being to promote its careers service and system in keeping with its educational mission. Students can opt out of being entered into the competition by contacting <u>careers@uhi.ac.uk</u> by the 1st February 2024.

Your data will, or may, be shared with the following recipients or categories of recipient:

Your personal data will not be shared with any party other than UHI for the competition purposes. The details of winners will be deleted once the prizes have been given out (unless winners give consent for publicity when contacted).

Named winners will be announced through the University Social Media Channels – only if they consent to this when asked.

Your data will be retained by the University and Academic Partners for the following period:

Details of competition winners will be deleted for the competition purposes once the prizes have been administered. Further processing for publicity purposes may take place if winners consent to this (a privacy notice will be provided).

The following rights are rights of data subjects:

- The right to access your personal data
- The right to rectification if the personal data we hold about you is incorrect
- The right to restrict processing of your personal data

The following rights apply only in certain circumstances:

- The right to withdraw consent at any time if consent is our lawful basis for processing your data
- The right to object to our processing of your personal data
- The right to request erasure (deletion) of your personal data
- The right to data portability

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office about our handling of your data.
